

Emereau Uniform Policy



1. Tops (Polos & Shirts)

- **Polos:** Black, White, or Kiwi Green (Leinwands has the correct green shirt)
- **Spirit Shirts:** These are the tshirts that are purchased through the school. Beta, Athletics, and other special Emereau tshirts are counted as Spirit shirts. Allowed on designated days (K-5: PE days & Fridays; Middle School: Thursday & Friday)
- **Outerwear:** Black, Gray, White, or Green; can be worn **inside**
- **3/4 Zip Pullovers:** Allowed if in school colors
- **Hoodies:** Emereau-purchased hoodies only

2. Bottoms

- **Pants or Shorts :** Black or Gray
- **Sweatpants:** Black or Gray Allowed on PE days (K-5) and Thursday & Friday (Middle School)
- **Leggings:** Solid Black, White, or Gray; may be worn **under skirts, skorts, jumpers, or dresses**
 - **✗ Leggings may not be worn as pants**

3. Dresses, Skorts, & Jumpers

- May be worn with leggings underneath

4. Footwear

- **Required:** Closed-toe shoes (safe for recess/playground)
- **✗ Not allowed:** Slides, Crocs, Sandals, Flip-Flops

5. Blue Jeans

- Allowed on Fridays (K-5) or on Spirit Shirt Days (Middle School)

6. Special Notes

- Spirit Shirts and sweatpants are **optional uniform days**, depending on grade level
- All clothing worn **inside the building** must adhere to the uniform colors

Accessories & Personal Items

- Earrings: up to 2 pairs
 - No body piercings beyond studs
 - Bookbags, lunch boxes, and purses: any color, no inappropriate images or writing
 - No rolling bookbags
 - Hats/scarves/gloves: outside only
 - No blankets, pillows, or wraps
 - No writing/drawing on self or others

Medical Exceptions

Requests must include:

- Doctor's documentation (diagnosis, modification, time frame)
 - Approval from school administration

Category	Allowed	Not Allowed
Polo Shirts	Black, White, or Kiwi Green with Emereau logo	Non-logo shirts, other colors
Spirit Shirts	K-5: PE days & Fridays; Middle School: Thursday & Friday	Other days, off-color shirts
Jumpers / Polo-Style Dresses	With Emereau logo	Without logo
Pants	Black or Gray; neat, no rips or sagging	Other colors, ripped, sagging
Shorts / Skorts	Black or Gray; 4" from top of kneecap or longer	Other colors, too short, ripped
Jeans / Sweatpants	Blue jeans or sweatpants on Friday (K-5) or Thursday–Friday (Middle School)	Other colors, ripped, worn any other day
Tights / Leggings	Solid Black, White, Gray; worn under skirts/skorts/dresses	Worn as pants; other colors
Outerwear	Emereau hoodies; 3/4 zip pullovers; coats/jackets in Black, White, Gray, or Emereau Green	Non-school colors inside; non-Emereau hoodies
Footwear	Closed-toe shoes; boots	Crocs, slides, sandals, flip-flops
Accessories	Minimal jewelry; belts if needed	Hats/hoods inside (unless medical/religious)
General	Uniform worn daily; clothing clean & in good repair	Writing, drawing, or altering clothing
