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## **Emereau Bladen Charter School Attendance Policy**

**School Year: 2025–2026**

### **Purpose**

Regular attendance is essential for academic success. Emereau Bladen Charter School is committed to promoting consistent attendance and following North Carolina's Compulsory Attendance Law (§ 115C-378). This policy outlines procedures for attendance monitoring and communication with families.

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### **1. Compulsory Attendance**

Students between the ages of 7 and 16 are required by law to attend school regularly. Emereau Bladen monitors attendance closely and collaborates with families to address barriers to attendance.

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### **2. Excused Absences**

Absences will be excused for the following reasons with appropriate documentation:

- Personal illness or injury
- Medical or dental appointments
- Death in the immediate family
- Quarantine
- Court or administrative proceedings
- Religious observances



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- Approved educational opportunities (requires prior written approval)
- Deployment activity of a parent/legal guardian who is an active-duty military member

A written note from the parent/guardian must be provided within **seven (7) days** of the student's return to school. Notes after seven days will not be accepted, and the absence will remain unexcused.

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### **3. Unexcused Absences**

An absence is unexcused if it does not meet the above criteria or if required documentation is not provided within the designated time.

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### **4. Tardiness and Early Dismissals**

Students arriving late or leaving early without valid reason or documentation will be marked **tardy unexcused**. Excessive tardies may result in the same interventions as absences.

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### **5. Attendance Notification Process**

In compliance with NCDPI guidelines and G.S. § 115C-378, the following actions will be taken:

#### **3 Unexcused Absences:**

- Parent/guardian will receive a **written notice** stating the number of unexcused absences and reminding them of the compulsory attendance law.
- School staff may make a phone call to discuss any concerns or support needs.

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- A **second written notice** will be sent.
- Parent/guardian may be required to attend a **conference with school administration/counselor** to develop an Attendance Improvement Plan (AIP).
- School counselor and/or support staff will work with the family to identify barriers and resources.

**10 Unexcused Absences:**

- A **final written notice** will be issued informing the parent that the student is in violation of the compulsory attendance law. A required meeting with the Executive Director and the Social Worker will take place to discuss the attendance plan and next steps.
- The school is legally obligated to **notify the Bladen County Truancy Officer** and may file a report with the **Department of Social Services (DSS)** and/or the **District Attorney** if the attendance issue persists.

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**6. Make-Up Work**

Students are responsible to make up missed work within a time frame equal to the number of days absent. (Example: 3 days absent, 3 days to make up the work) Students should arrange to obtain assignments from their teacher upon their return to school.

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**7. Chronic Absenteeism**

Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10% or more of the school year for **any reason** (excused or unexcused). Chronic absenteeism will trigger interventions through the school's Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) team.



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### 8. Review

This policy will be reviewed annually and updated to ensure compliance with all local and state laws.
